Elstead Parish Council is looking to co-opt 1 individual to fill the Parish Councillor vacancy.

To be eligible you must qualify under *one* of the provisions of Section 79 of the Local Government Act 1972, i.e.

- a) be on the electoral register for the Parish;
- b) have owned or rented land in the Parish for 12 months;
- c) have worked in the Parish for 12 months;
- d) have lived in the Parish or within 3 miles of the Parish boundary for 12 months.
- e) must be 18 years of age or over.

Members are bound by the Local Government Code of Conduct.

The Council meets once a month, with additional planning and other meetings when required. It is responsible for managing the Parish Precept, considering local planning applications, providing and maintaining recreational and cemetery facilities and representing residents' views and interests locally and nationally.
